Membership Categories

Membership shall consist of Individual, Family, or Associate:

Individual:

This applies to any single individual aged 8 or over (on 1st January of the subscription year) and entitles the individual to take part in any of the coached sessions in any water sport offered. Those aged 16 or over shall have one vote, exercisable in person at any General Meeting, for those aged below 16 this single vote will be exercisable by a parent or guardian. This membership is suitable for both younger paddlers and those who are “not so young also.

In addition any individual who also meets the criteria for associate membership will be entitled to apply for such membership at no additional cost.

Family:

This applies to any and all members of the same family unit. Including spouse and children under the age of 18 years on 1st January of the subscription year and named on the membership form. A family member and designated partner shall each have one vote, exercisable in person at any general meeting. Family members will each be entitled to take part in any coached sessions in any water sport offered.

In addition any individual who also meets the criteria for associate membership will be entitled to apply for such membership at no additional cost.

Associate Membership:

Associate members must be over 18 years of age on 1st January of the subscription year. Associate members are not eligible to attend the coached sessions (other than in a coaching capacity) and must have a demonstrable experience of kayak paddling. Such experience must include the ability to rescue and be rescued when paddling in a group. As a guide a minimum level of SCA 2 Star personal award with post attainment experience should be held, ideally paddlers should have reached a 3 Star SCA personal award level in either Sea Kayaking or Touring – or equivalent. Associate members are expected to be capable of looking after their own safety and come suitably prepared for the session, no formal coaching will be provided on these paddles.

Should you be unsure of which membership is suitable for you please do not hesitate to contact us direct to discuss. Our aim is to have enjoyable but ultimately safe paddling on the water for all involved.

Sessions details

Coaching Sessions (for adults and young paddlers) take place weekly on a Sunday at 10.00am to 12.00pm (approx.) – meet at the Water sport Shed (at playpark across from Ardrishaig Co-op). Associate sessions will take place fortnightly, meeting places for these will vary and be posted via the closed Facebook page (closed group page – details provided on membership) approximately 2-3 days before. Usually the aim will be for a 1-1.30pm start (dependant on start venue) and sessions will last approximately 2-3 hours, the aim of such sessions is to allow paddlers to practice and develop existing skills within a friendly group environment that aims to paddle on a regular basis. Buoyancy aids and equipment will be provided, but suitable clothing and footwear should be worn (see website for details), bringing a towel is also a good idea.

We will endeavour to provide a coached session wherever possible and will always try to provide a suitable but safe alternative during periods of wet/windy weather.

All sessions may be subject to short notice changes due to weather conditions and any changes will be posted on the Facebook group page (general). It is possible that if the weather is unsuitable for coached sessions to take place on the sea the venue may change to the canal which offers better shelter such decisions will be taken as appropriate.
